Murder trials are just all in the family for lawyers

Trifecta: Three lawyers named **Denaro** in murder trials. Papa **Jack**, 59, is defending accused drug kingpin **Sal Magluta** before U.S. District Judge **Patricia Seitz**. Daughter **Dawn**, 35, a Miami-Dade assistant state attorney, just prosecuted **Audrick Tillman** for the September 2000 robbery-slaying of bar owner **Adolph King Jr.** Jury hung — 11-1 for conviction. Retrial set for June 3 before Circuit Judge **Pedro Echarte Jr.** Son **Joel**, 30, an assistant public defender, along with co-counsel **Patrick Nally**, 48, and **Michael Melinek**, 46, are in trial before Circuit Judge **Kevin Emas**. They represent handyman **Oriel Bernadeu**, charged with the May '98 slaying of **Carlos Juan Tamayo**, a middle school science teacher and, cops say, suspected coke dealer. Death penalty case.
